

## SIMMENTAL - JUNIOR BREEDING HEIFERS

Simmental Breeding Heifer Show 8 a.m. Tuesday, Jan. 18<sup>th</sup>

All rules for Simmental open show apply to this division. Females in this division must be registered in the American Simmental Association (1/2-blood or higher are accepted in this show).

Youth exhibitors should send a copy of their junior entry form to Colorado Simmental Association, 24614 Rd G, Sugar City, CO 81076. Juniors wishing to enter the Open Show must do so on a National Western Breeding Show entry form and send CSA open show fees (see Simmental show 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph of premium book).

Junior show heifers must be checked in & processed with open class entries on Sunday afternoon, Jan. 16<sup>th</sup> on the hill. Original registration certificates on each animal must be available for inspection. The heifer **must be in the junior's name** (National Western's Junior Livestock rule #7) to show. Any animal not having a legible tattoo which matches the registration certificate will be barred from showing.

855. Percentage senior heifer calves, calved Sept.-Dec. 2009.....	A
856. Percentage summer yearling heifers, calved Jan.-Aug. 2009.....	A
Champion and Reserve champion percentage heifers .....	C

Purebred heifers - Heifers must be 7/8-blood Simmental or higher

845. Purebred late spring heifer calves, calved after May 1, 2010 .....	A
846. Purebred early spring heifer calves, calved March-April 2010.....	A
847. Purebred junior heifer calves, calved Jan-Feb 2010.....	A
848. Purebred senior heifer calves, calved Sept-Dec 2009.....	A
849. Purebred summer yearling heifers, calved May-Aug 2009.....	A
850. Purebred late junior yearling heifers, calved March-April 2009.....	A
851. Purebred early junior yearling heifers, calved Jan-Feb 2009.....	A
Champion and Reserve champion purebred heifers .....	C

Depending upon the number of entries, classes may be split at the discretion of CSA. If a class is split, premiums will also be split.
